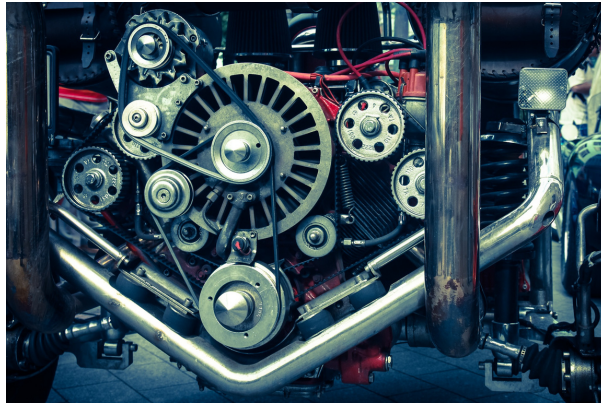


# EVERYDAY INVENTORS
